in Paris, three in New York, two in

Tel-Aviv. Got a first prize for pain Israelian painting in 1952. Was selected for the "Prix de la critique" in Paris

twice, in 1951 and 1954. My work is acquired by the French state and the municipality of Paris, by all the Isralie museums, by the Rockefeller foundation in New York, and many private collections. Am having a one man show in Tel-Aviv national museum
