Aynard har h rt, at K pcke har problemer med at sende deres v rker retur, Hun er meget forbavset, aftalen blev truffet seks m neder inden udstillingens start. Hun har ingen penge nu og kan ikke s lge noget, eftersom hovedparten af hendes v rker er hos K pcke. Hun g r opm rksom p , at der b de var en tolk og en sagf rer med, da aftalen blev ing et med Nicolaus. Hun er meget overrasket over, at der ikke er blevet solgt noget og  grgrer sig i det hele taget over de kedelige forviklinger. Hun tilf jer til sidst, at Nicolaus i sin tid havde sagt, at returtransporten ville blive betalt af K pcke.

TRANSSKRIFTION

Dear Sir I hear that you are making difficulties to send our pictures back. I can't believe it. We were quite regular in our contact with you, signed six months before the exhibition, and you can't now deprive us of our work. I haven't any money now and can't sell anything if you keep the best part of my paintings with you. We had a translator and a lawyer to witness the engagement with Mr. Nicolaus. I am very surprised you didn't sell any of my paintings; and extremely disappointed with all these very unpleasant entanglements. Will you please close all this and not oblige us to go to our consulates and so on. Kind regards R Aynard

P.S. Mr Nicolaus even promised us that you would send us back the pictures at your cost.
